Pictured below is Lil Scadding, after whom the Prestigious perpetual Memorial Pavilion Trophy, The Lil Scadding Trophy is named.


Did you know that when the family first donated the Trophy in 1985 that there were many more sections to be contested for points, including wool, sheep, cattle, goats and poultry?

Lil Scadding was actively involved in the Wentworth Show Society from Post Second World War until her death in 1985. She was a committee member from 1969 and the first female president of the Show Society in 1977-78.

Hilda Moylan was one of the first regular winners of the trophy

Since 1990 Cheryl Vines, (pictured below with Tony Douglas in 2002 and with Dianne Pollard above in 2024), has been consistently entering the pavilion competitions. Cheryl has won the Lil Scadding trophy continuously for the past 26 years, except for the two Covid-19 years that the show wasn't held.

The original sponsorship came from Mildura Wines and then the Wentworth Show Society and was awarded to one competitor only, initially.
