RULES & REGULATIONS

- An Indemnity Waiver form must be signed by all people on the showgrounds that may come into contact with an animal before entering the ring. A wristband will be provided as proof of having signed the waiver – **no signed Indemnity waiver form, no wristband, no entry, no exceptions!**
- Competitors are responsible for being aware of and adhering to current biosecurity guidelines. Visit www.dpi.nsw.gov.au and please read the biosecurity guidelines carefully.
- All competitors must complete a horse health declaration before entering the arena.
- Wentworth Show Society Inc. will not tolerate bullying, harassment, adverse behaviour or offensive language by any person at our show. Any person involved in these behaviours will be escorted from the showgrounds at the discretion of the Disputes Committee and may be banned from future shows across NSW.
- It shall be the condition of entry that Wentworth Show Society Inc. shall not be held responsible or liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss to person or property whilst on the showgrounds or participating in our event.
- Wentworth Show Society Inc. reserves the right to alter the program without notification.
- The onus is on the competitor to enter the correct class.
- No event will be held up for late competitors.
- No refunds on unused tickets.
- This event is affiliated with AgShows NSW, ENSW and VAS Ltd. It is run under peak body rules.
- Electric leads must be covered or disconnected and have a current test tag.
- EA Safety Approved Helmets are to be worn at all times by all riders when mounted.
- Stallion / Colts may compete in Showjumping and Western rings only, and must be led or ridden by an adult, over the age of 18 years.
- A Judge may ask a competitor to retire from an event or ring providing they can show just cause.
- No dogs are permitted at the Wentworth Showgrounds.
- No fires are to be lit on Wentworth Showgrounds.
- Horse exhibitors are expected to remove all their horse's excrement from the showgrounds.
- No electric fences.
- No horse is to be left unattended at the showground.
- In the case of a quarantine lockdown, the owner is responsible for their own and their horse's welfare.
- The Judge's decision is final.

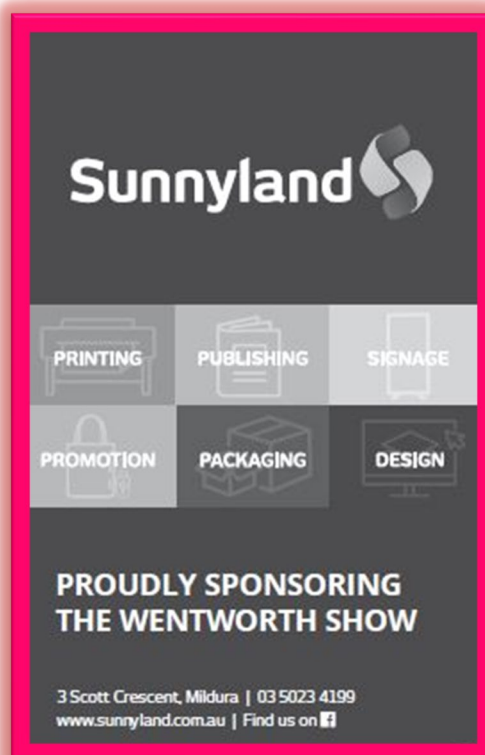
